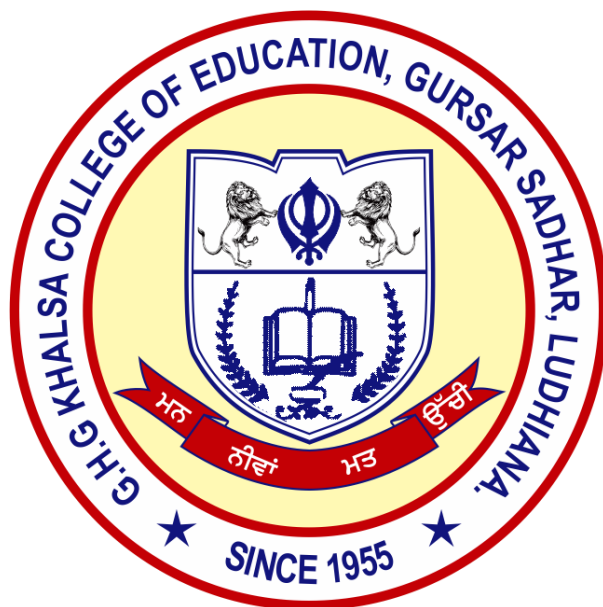

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## **Annual Report 2019-20**

It gives me immense pleasure to present the Annual Report of G.H.G Khalsa college of Education for the year 2019-20. This annual report is a testimony that the College has elevated itself to a higher level of development in the field of education. All this has become possible due to prodigious support of our visionary College Governing Council headed by S. Manjit Singh Gill, faculty members and very cooperative and well-disciplined students. We at G.H.G Khalsa College of Education strongly believe in the concept of holistic education and strive to achieve its goal of preparing students to meet the challenges that we face in the twenty-first century. Guided by this principle, we prepare our students not only for academic success but also for life. Through this report I would like to present a brief summary of our achievements on the academic, co-curricular and the extra-curricular front for the year 2019-20.

### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

The foundation stone of this historic institute was laid way back in 1921. This college has a proud heritage of excellence and innovation. This prestigious institute is blessed as it stands in the name of the **Sixth Guru, Guru Har Gobind Sahib Ji**, who donned the swords of Miri-Piri that symbolize spiritual and temporal authority. The story of its growth from a small institution in the pre-independence India to a well-established ‘Seat of Learning’ of the present times is a saga of dedication, conviction and vision of Late Nihang Shamsheer Singh who worked against all odds and saw it growing step by step. This pious place was converted into Gurmukhi Pathshala in 1921 which he preferred to call a college. The Pathshala flourished into a High School by the year 1928 and with his untiring efforts an intermediate college was started in 1948 which became a degree college later on.

It was in the year 1955 that the present G.H.G Khalsa College of Education came into being and the herculean task of training the ‘Nation Builders’ was started with the establishment of B.T with a sanctioned strength of 100 seats. The College attained the stature of post-graduate institution with the inclusion of M.Ed. in 1982.

At present, the college has a sanctioned strength of 100 seats of B.Ed. and 50 for M.Ed. course. It is permanently affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, is recognized by the N.C.T.E and has been accredited with **Grade ‘A’** (i.e. Very Good College) by NAAC i.e. National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore an autonomous body of U.G.C, Govt. of India consecutively for two accreditation cycles (CGPA-3.04 in cycle-I and CGPA-3.30 in cycle-II).

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The college has contributed a lot to this area by producing thousands of professionally qualified male and female teachers. The college motto **“Man Neevan, Mat Uchi”** clearly reflects its goals and mission. The main aim of the college is to produce well-informed, skilled and effective teachers for secondary schools and Colleges of Education. Besides **producing ‘teachers’ for Secondary Schools**, and **‘lecturers’ for Colleges of Education**, we are also producing **‘Principals’ for Colleges of Education**. It is interesting to note that more than 15 Colleges of Education in Punjab have Principals from this college. This college is also known as **“NURSERY OF PRINCIPALS”**.

Active research is the backbone of an educational institute. This college has been known as the renowned center of quality research. All the Staff members are Doctorate and majority of them are guiding research work at Doctorate and Post graduate level and are engrossed in academic activities of high esteem. The college is an institutional member of Council for Teacher Education (CTE) and life member of All India Association of Educational Research (AIAER). Envisioning a global society, the college curriculum is imbued with a distinct international perspective, with this farsighted vision the college has achieved many milestones and has made a significant standing at National and International levels. We encourage our prospective teachers to keep themselves abreast with changes taking place across the globe and prepare themselves for global citizenship.

### **Pedagogical & Cultural activities**

**Mentor System and Morning Assembly:** With a view to render an affective level to the teacher education programme and to provide better individualized help and guidance, the college follows the mentor group system. All the 202 students of the college have been randomly divided into 13 groups and have been assigned a mentor from the staff. The students meet their mentors

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periodically once a week, they are also encouraged to consult their mentors in case of any academic or personal problems. The Mentor groups in charges maintain the cumulative record profile of each students of their group and monitor their progress throughout the session. Each group also organizes one morning assembly which is a weekly feature of the college calendar. All the students of a group collectively organize and participate in these assemblies which are a forum to teach public speaking along with inculcating moral and religious values.

**Internship Programme:** All the B.Ed students of semester III attended the Internship Programme (Field Based Engagement) from July 24- November 24, 2019.

### **Swachhta Pakhwada**

Students and faculty of the College observed Swachhta Pakhwada Fortnight in their respective Internship schools from August 1- 15, 2019. The event was organized as per the directions of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Dept. of Youth Affairs, Directorate of National Service Scheme, New Delhi. A cultural programme was organized on the occasion in which students of B.Ed Ist Semester and M.Ed III Semester gave a wonderful performance by sharing their views on the Teachers' day in the form of poem recitations, power point presentations and speeches on the theme "Importance of teachers in the life of students".

## **INFRASTRUCTURE & LEARNING RESOURCES**

The college has built a modern infrastructure in the form of multi story buildings for M.Ed. and B.Ed. courses, with all the requisite facilities for healthy and facilitative academic environment.

### **At present the college has:**

- A Wi- Fi campus with leased line connection facility. The computer lab provides numerous computing facilities for its students and faculty members. The computer lab has more than 53 computers with latest operating systems and latest software. In addition the college also has Laptops, Smart board, Visualiser etc. The E.T. lab has 9 LCD projectors, 12 overhead

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projectors, 6 LCD televisions in addition to other equipment. ERP software developed by the college has been initiated for college automation.

- A prominent feature of the college is language lab having a facility of 20 users. It focuses on training pupils in Pronunciation, Group discussions, Extempore, Drill activities etc.
- Psychology and Guidance Laboratory has nearly 100 Psychological tests.
- The college has a fully functional Internal Quality Assurance Cell which was established in 2009. The main aim of IQAC is planning, implementing and measuring the outcomes of academic and administrative performance of the college.
- Smart Classroom with Learning Gallery is used to teach faculty and students to integrate technology in their lives.
- The Science & Mathematics lab is well equipped with scientific devices to enhance teaching-learning process.
- Art and Craft Resource room is used to develop and nurture creative talent among the students. It is fully equipped with materials which help the students to prepare charts, models and other teaching aids.
- Sports room with Gymnasium is available within campus for the students as well as the faculty.
- College has a fully functional Research Cell in order to promote research activities among the students and the staff.
- Method Laboratory is well equipped to sharpen the teaching skills of the student teachers. It is used to record the lessons delivered by them.
- Separate hostel facilities have been provided for boys and girls with all amenities like coolers, geysers, LCD TV and computer with Internet facility.

### **LIBRARY**

Numerous books are added to the college library stock every year, this year too the college Library Committee purchased books and journals worth Rs. 41,229. At present the college library has

It consists of number of National and International journals, educational surveys, research books, dissertations, Ph.D. theses, research oriented magazines etc. This cell provides the best resources to pursue the research work under one roof.
- In the library a Rare Section is maintained which has very old books.
