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ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The foundation stone of this historic institute was laid way back in 1921. This college has a proud heritage of excellence and innovation. This prestigious institute is blessed as it stands in the name of the **Sixth Guru, Guru Har Gobind Sahib Ji**, who donned the swords of Miri-Piri that symbolize spiritual and temporal authority. The story of its growth from a small institution in the pre-independence India to a well-established “Seat of Learning” of the present times is a saga of dedication, conviction and vision of Late Nihang Shamsheer Singh who worked against all odds and saw it growing step by step. A Gurmukhi Pathshala was established at this pious place in 1921 by Late Nihang Shamsheer Singh which he preferred to call a college. The Pathshala flourished into a High School by the year 1928 and with his untiring efforts an intermediate college was started in 1948 which became a degree college later on.

It was in the year 1955 that the present G.H.G Khalsa College of Education came into being and the noble task of training the “Nation Builders” was started with the establishment of B.T with a sanctioned strength of 100 seats. The College attained the stature of post-graduate institution with the inclusion of M.Ed. in 1982.

At present, the college has a sanctioned strength of 100 seats of B.Ed. and 50 for M.Ed. course. It is permanently affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, is recognized by the N.C.T.E and has been accredited with **Grade “A”**(i.e. Very Good College) by NAAC i.e. National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore an autonomous body of U.G.C, Govt. of India consecutively for two accreditation cycles (CGPA-3.04 in cycle-I and CGPA-3.30 in cycle-II).College has attained the status of Mentor Institution under the UGC scheme / Paramarsh scheme.

The college has contributed a lot to this area by producing thousands of professionally qualified male and female teachers. The college motto “**Man Neevan, Mat Uchi**” clearly reflects its goals and mission. The main aim of the college is to produce well-informed, skilled and effective teachers for secondary schools and Colleges of Education. Besides **producing teachers for Secondary Schools**, and **lecturers for Colleges of Education**, we are also producing “**Principals for Colleges of Education**”. It is interesting to note that more than 15 Colleges of Education in Punjab have Principals from this college. This college is also known as “**NURSERY OF PRINCIPALS**”.

G.H.G. Khalsa College of Education has always taken great pride in its enviable record of academic, sports and cultural activities and accomplishments. The college results in university exams have always been around 100 percent for B.Ed and M.Ed. The college has won PU Overall Sports Championship (Education and Evening colleges) for 13 times, Athletic Championship for 22 times and has bagged PU Overall Runners up trophy in sports 3 times. On the cultural front, the college has won the overall trophy in Panjab University Annual Youth and Heritage festival two times and Runners Up trophy four times.

MoU with A.S. College Khanna

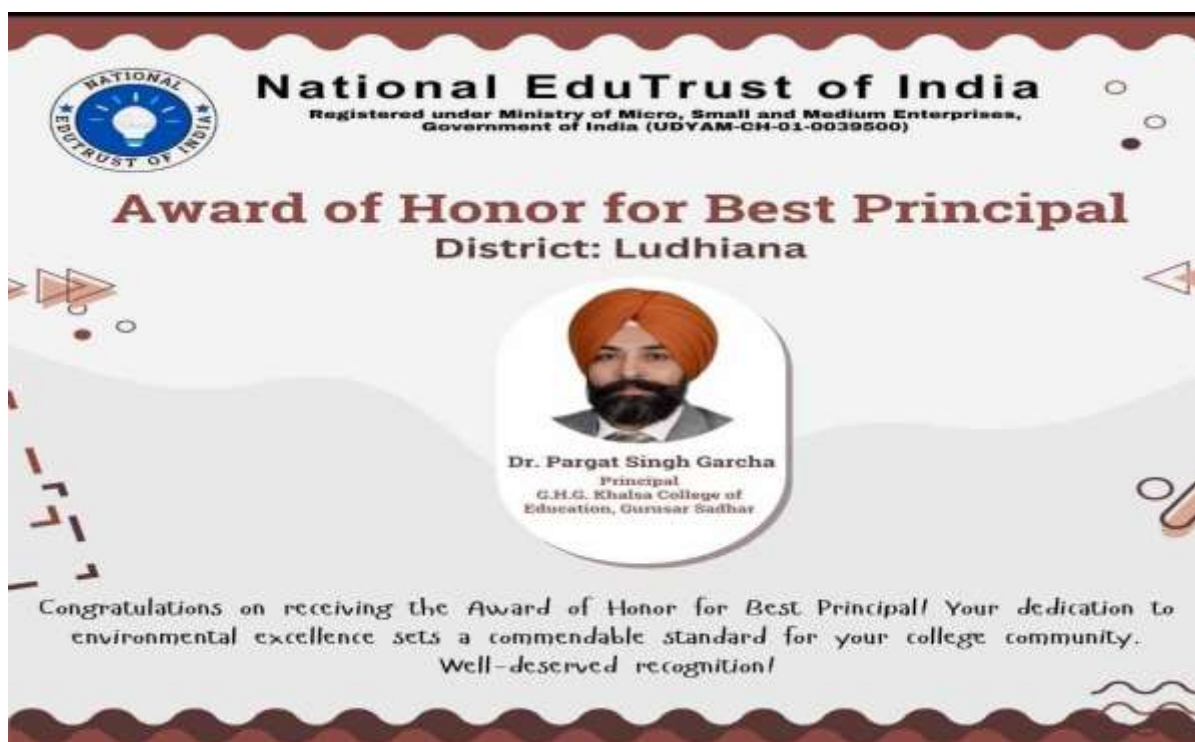

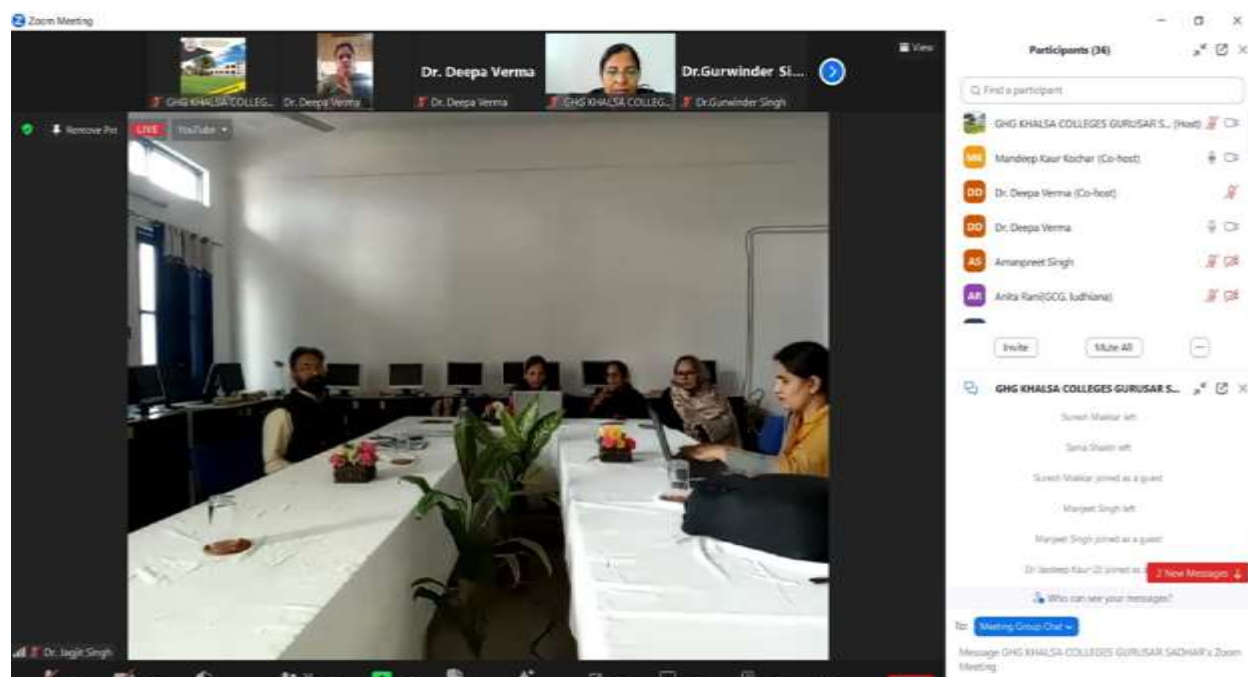
Faculty Development Programme/Seminars organized

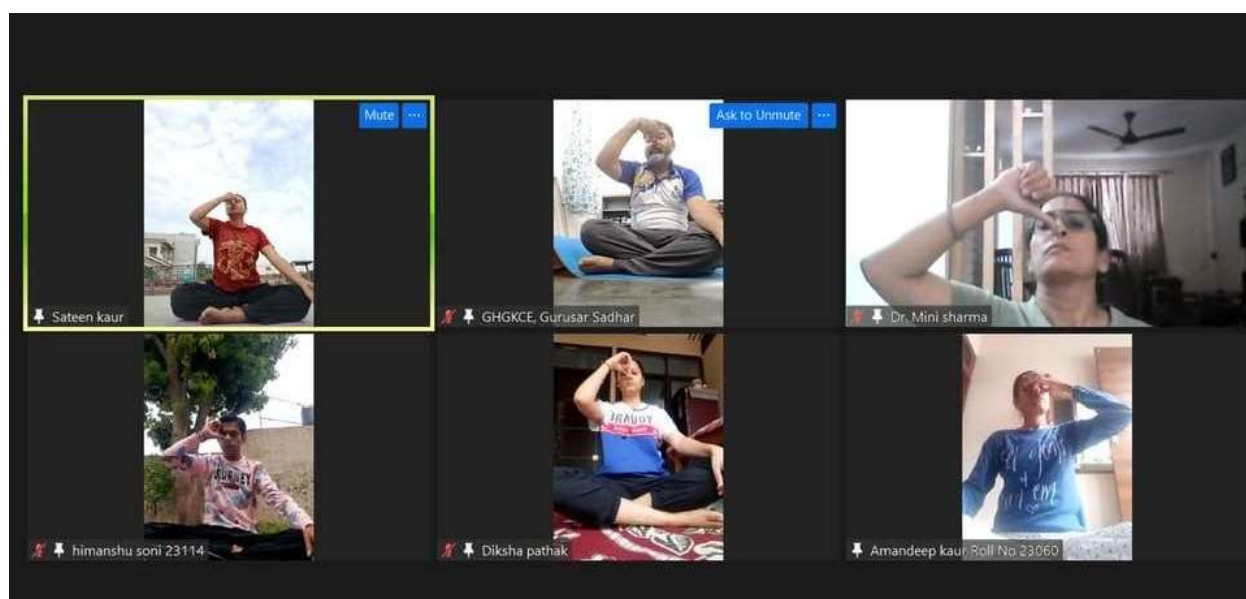


International Yoga Day
