This year Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the festival on January 12 in Huballi, Karnataka. 26th National Youth Festival celebrated as Green Youth Festival where only reusable cutlery, napkins etc. were used. Apart from that, all the mementos, medals and stationery are also reusable material. The basic

objective of National Youth Day was to bring the youth of the country together in an attempt to showcase their talents in various activities to cover almost all socio-cultural aspects of life, providing an opportunity to amateur young artists to express themselves and interact with fellow artists and to further learn the new art forms from experts of various disciplines. The National Youth Festival in India is an annual gathering of youth with various activities including competitive ones.
