

Report of the N.S.S. Camp-7 Days (December 20, 2017 to December 26, 2017)- N.S.S. units of G.H.G. Khalsa College of Education, Gurusar Sudhar organized a seven days N.S.S. Camp from December 20, 2017 to December 26, 2017 Under the supervision of the Programme Officers Prof. Rachhpal Singh and Dr. Jasvir Kaur. A total number of 92 volunteers (17 boys, 58 girls and 17 Non-student) participated in this camp. All the volunteers worked for these seven days with appreciable dedication and high motivation. On December 19, Pre N.S.S. Camp arrangements were made which included assembly of volunteers where various committees of NSS Volunteers were formed purchase of necessary items, arrangement of cooks and helpers etc. were made. Also the volunteers were divided into different committees viz. 

The beat covid campaign helped the NSS wing to intensify its efforts in beating the second wave of covid-19 which had hardly hit the country. As you all know that the second wave of covid 19 was quite intense in the rural parts of the country and are college is located in the rural area. hence it was all the more necessary that the NSS volunteers should double their efforts of creating awareness regarding the spread of covid-19 the precautions required the importance of vaccination and also extending support to the people suffering from coronavirus.

Therefore the NSS wing carried out the beat covid campaign from June 5 to June 24, 2021 As instructed by the authorities an orientation of the NSS volunteers regarding the campaign was done through the WhatsApp group in which the program officers acquainted the students about the objectives of the campaign and the proposed activities. Nearly 60 students were given the orientation out of which 50 students actively joined the campaign. 5 faculty members Dr. Jasleen Kaur, Dr. Rachhpal Singh, Dr. Jagjit Singh, Dr. Jasbir kaur Sarna and Mrs. Rupinder jit Kaur were also involved in this campaign to guide and organise the activities to be carried out by the volunteers. The students were then divided into group of 5 teams as instructed, i.e. hospital management team, Non hospital management team, medical Essentials team, family support team and psychosocial support team. Each team was under the supervision of 1 teacher incharge.

A meeting of the teacher in charges and student representatives of each team was held with the principal, one week before the campaign had to started. A proper plan was chalked out about the activities of the 20 days and the functioning of each team, the nature of duties to be discharged, arrangement of resources, sources for gathering information etc.

As during the time period between 5th June and 24th June covid wave was quite intense in the country, the student volunteers were not called in the college campus, all the Communications were made through the WhatsApp group specially formed for this purpose. The students were instructed to carry out the activities in their nearby areas, as majority of the students of our college belong to rural areas we could cover nearly 21 villages in this campaign. An added advantage which we got was that 15% of our students come from all India quota and Airforce Station, Halwara is in the vicinity, many student volunteers were from different states of India, therefore the beneficiaries of this campaign were beyond the state of Punjab as well.

#### Activities of hospital management team

We wanted to keep the activities of the campaign more service oriented rather than being heavily budgeted. As the students were functioning from their homes we did not want to put them in any type of financial or health crisis. So they were instructed to follow the guidelines of covid-19 while discharging their duties. The student volunteers in the hospital management team were asked to visit nearby vaccination centres for covid-19 and render services in helping the staff of the centres to organise the vaccination campaign in a more organised manner. Our volunteers help in setting up the stage, that is to say the counselled the people in the waiting areas of the vaccination centres, this was required to help people break myths about the vaccination especially in the rural areas. Our volunteers counselled them by telling the benefits of the vaccination and removing their doubts and fears they also helped in queuing up the people to avoid chaos at the vaccination centres, They helped in maintaining social distancing and also help the hospital staff as and when required. Our volunteers helped in vaccination centres in gurusar Sudhar, mullanpur, Jagraon and Raikot.

#### Non hospital management


#### **Constitution Day celebration in the college campus:**


