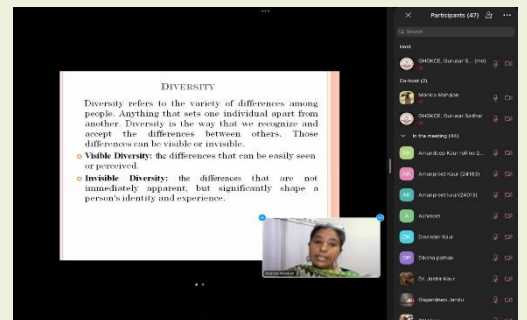

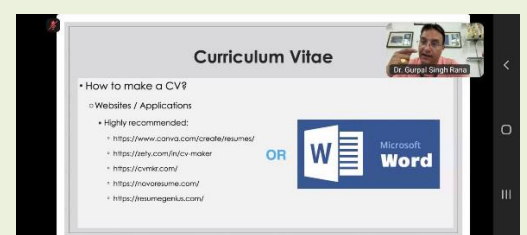

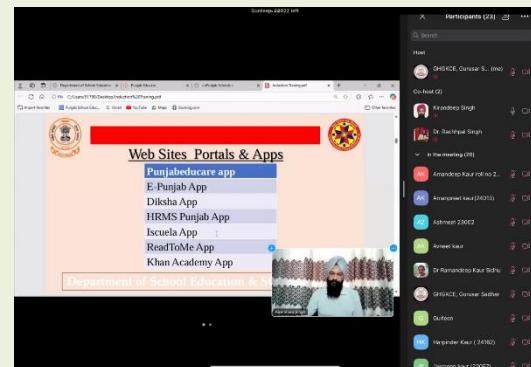

House Examinations Commence at GHG Khalsa College of Education

Semester 2 & 4, and PG Diploma in Guidance and Counseling Semester 2. These examinations are a mandatory component of the academic calendar and serve as essential preparatory assessments for the upcoming Panjab University final



examinations. The exams were held in a systematic and disciplined manner, helping students evaluate their academic progress and readiness while also fostering a serious examination environment.



Promoting Academic Excellence Through Structured Guidance and Collaborative Learning

GHG Khalsa College of Education, Gurusar Sadhar, conducted its house examinations from April 15 to 25, 2026, under the leadership of Principal Dr. Pargat Singh Garcha. The examination process was efficiently overseen by Dr. Jasbir Sarna and Dr. Jasleen Kaur, who served as house examination judges to ensure smooth execution and academic integrity.

To enhance the learning experience, a thoughtfully crafted timetable was introduced by Dr. Ramandeep Kaur Sidhu. This schedule incorporated dedicated preparatory sessions prior to the exams each day. The first period (9:30 AM to 10:00 AM) was devoted to supervised learning, where students revised their subjects under the guidance of their teachers. These sessions provided opportunities for doubt-clearing and reinforcing key concepts.

Following this, the second period (10:00 AM to 10:30 AM) was reserved for peer-to-peer interaction, encouraging cooperative learning through group discussions, team teaching, and collaborative problem-solving. The examinations commenced daily at 10:45 AM, giving students ample time to engage in both teacher-guided and peer-supported learning beforehand.
