## July 12, 2024

#### Introduction:

#### **Organizers:**

The Faculty Development Programme was organized under the patronship of Dr. Pargat Singh Garcha (Principal) and the IQAC Cell of GHG Khalsa College of Education under Dr. Manu Chadha(Convener) and Organising Committee members Dr. Ramandeep Kaur Sidhu and Dr. Mini Sharma. The organizing committee ensured the smooth conduct of the sessions and coordinated with various resource persons to deliver valuable content to the participants.

#### Participants:

The FDP was attended by faculty members, administrative staff, and support staff of GHG Khalsa College of Education. The diverse group of participants included teaching faculty, and other personnel involved in the day-to-day operations of the college. Their active participation and engagement were crucial in making the programme successful.

#### **Objectives:**

- 1. Enhance Administrative Skills: Familiarize faculty and supporting staff with essential administrative tools and practices.
- 2.Boost Research Capabilities: Introduce AI tools and their applications to improve research activities.
- 3.Improve Financial and Record Management: Provide insights into effective financial management and record-keeping.
- 4. Develop Emotional and Social Skills: Explore psychological interventions to enhance emotional, social, and adversity quotients.
- 5. Equip with Practical Skills: Train faculty in first aid and holistic health practices.
- 6.Reinforce Professional Ethics: Strengthen understanding of professional ethical protocols and the institution's Code of Conduct.

## <sup>/</sup>Day 1: 12th July, 2024

#### Resource Person: Mr. Rajan Topic: How to Access ERP

A session on the ERP system was organized to acquaint teaching and support staff with its functionalities and advantages. The goal was to enhance their understanding and utilization of the ERP system to optimize college operations.



The session began with an overview of ERP systems, highlighting their role in integrating various administrative and academic functions. The presentation covered the key features and benefits of the college's ERP system. Detailed explanations were provided on the different user roles within the ERP system, outlining the specific permissions and functions available to teaching and support staff.

A live demonstration followed, showcasing how to navigate the ERP interface and execute essential tasks. This hands-on approach aimed to equip participants with practical skills to effectively use the ERP system in their daily responsibilities.

## Day 2: 13th July, 2024

#### Resource Person: Dr. Deepika Kohli Topic: Al Tools in Research

Dr. Deepika Kohli conducted a session on utilizing AI tools in research, designed to elevate faculty research capabilities through advanced AI technologies. Dr. Kohli began with an overview of AI's transformative impact on research, showcasing a range of AI tools including Google Scholar, Mendeley, NVivo, Atlas, SPSS, Stata, Anthropic's Claude, and OpenAI's GPT-3.



The session featured live demonstrations and practical examples to illustrate how these tools can be applied in research projects. It concluded with an interactive Q&A segment, providing participants an opportunity to discuss their experiences and address any challenges they faced with Al tools.

## <sup>/</sup>Day 3: 14th July, 2024

#### Mr. Harpal Singh & Mr. Karanpreet Singh Financial and Budgeting Management & Maintaining Office Records

The session on Financial and Budgeting Management and Maintaining Office Records was organized as part of the Faculty Development Programme (FDP) to enhance the administrative skills of faculty members as well as supporting staff of the College. The session aimed to provide insights into effective financial management, budgeting practices, and the maintenance of office records to ensure smooth and efficient administrative operations. The session covered the basic principles of budgeting, including:

- Understanding income and expenditure.
- Allocating resources effectively.
- Setting realistic financial goals.
- Monitoring and adjusting budgets as needed

The importance of maintaining accurate and organized office records was emphasized. Key topics included:

- Types of records to maintain (financial records, meeting minutes, correspondence, etc.).

- Using digital tools for record maintenance.

### Day 4: 15th July, 2024

#### Topic- Benefits of ESIC Scheme Resource Person- Mr. Iqbal Singh

A lecture on the benefits of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) scheme was organized in the Faculty Development Program (FDP) specifically for non-teaching staff. The session aimed to educate non-teaching staff about the various advantages and provisions of the ESIC scheme. The event saw active participation from non-teaching staff members, including the administrative and supporting staff of the College.

Mr. Iqbal Singh Channa, Labour Law Consultant was the resource person on the occasion. Mr. Iqbal Singh informed the non-teaching staff about the ESIC scheme and its benefits. He also explained the eligibility criteria and enrollment process. He provided the insights into the medical, financial, and social security benefits offered by the scheme. Mr. Iqbal also addressed the questions and concerns related to the ESIC scheme asked by the participants.





## Day 5: 16th July, 2024

#### Dr. Sudhir from CHC Sudhar First Aid Training



The session on First Aid Training was organized as part of the Faculty Development Programme (FDP) to equip faculty members with essential first aid skills. The goal was to ensure that faculty are prepared to respond effectively to medical emergencies, thereby enhancing the safety and well-being of the college community. Dr. Sudhir from the Community Health center, Sadhar was resource person on the occasion. The trainer discussed the critical role of first aid in emergency situations, highlighting how timely and appropriate interventions can save lives and reduce the severity of injuries. The trainer explained how to respond to various common medical emergencies, such as:

- Cardiac Arrest: Performing CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation).
- Bleeding: Applying pressure and bandaging wounds.
- Burns: Cooling the burn and covering it with a sterile dressing.
- Fractures: Immobilizing the injured area.

Participants engaged in hands-on training, practicing first aid techniques under the guidance of the trainer. Key activities included:

- CPR practice using mannequins.
- Bandaging techniques for various injuries.
- Methods for safely moving and positioning injured persons.

### Day 6: 15th July, 2024

#### Yoga tips & Herbal Remedies for Health care - Mr. Hoshiar Singh

The session on Yoga Tips and Herbal Remedies for Health Care was organized as part of the Faculty Development Programme (FDP) to promote holistic health and well-being among faculty members. The goal was to provide practical yoga techniques and knowledge of herbal remedies that can be incorporated into daily routines to enhance physical and mental health.



#### Practical yoga tips for daily practice were shared, including:

- Breathing Techniques (Pranayama): Techniques to improve respiratory function and reduce stress.

- Basic Asanas (Postures): Simple postures to enhance flexibility, strength, and balance.

- Meditation and Relaxation: Techniques to calm the mind and promote mental clarity.


