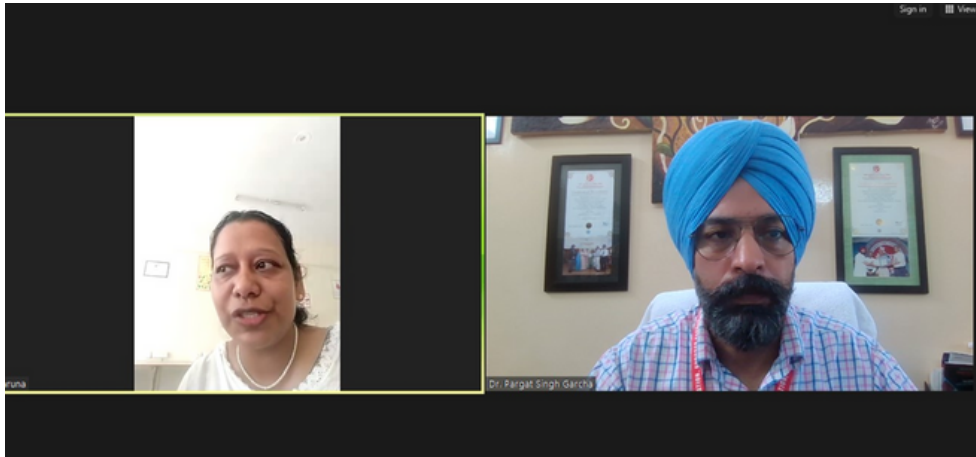
Report on Inauguration and Orientation of the Session 2024-26 at GHG Khalsa College of Education

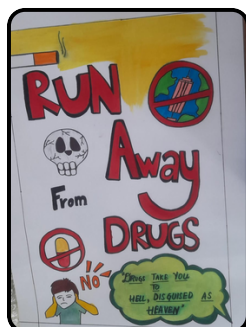
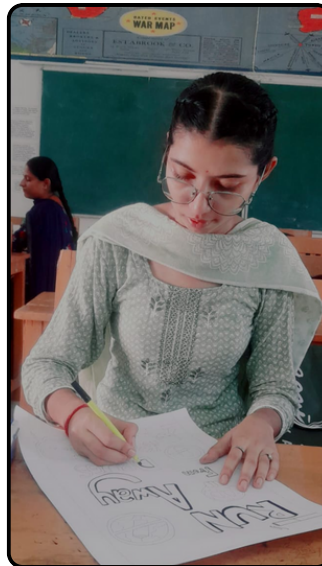
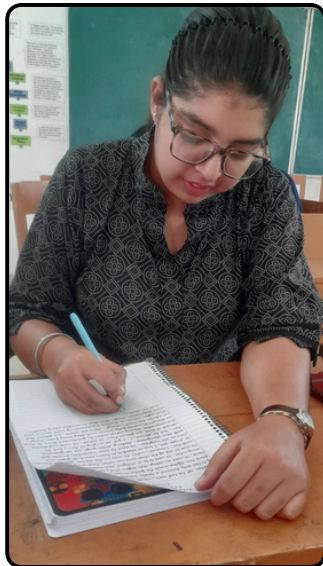
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Fine Arts and Literary Competitions
