Objectives of the Policy:

Segregation of the waste

• To collect and separate food waste and non-biodegradable waste in separate bins

Reducing the waste

- To follow paperless practices in the office and academic work by making use of information and communication technology (ERP and Learning Management System) thereby reducing the wastage of paper.
- To replace use and throw items like plastic cups, plates etc. used in the college canteen by reusable items like steel glasses and plates.
- To reuse the other side of the printed paper for writing/printing purpose.

Reusing the waste

• To use the strategy of reuse in managing the waste produced in the College like best out of waste, teaching learning material preparation and for preparing hanging/vertical garden.

Recycling the waste

- To use biodegradable waste like garden waste, dried leaves, waste papers etc.
 in preparing organic manure and compost through the process of vermicomposting.
- To help recycle the e-waste like obsolete electronic devices i.e. computer systems, server, monitors, compact disc, printers, scanners, fax machines, battery cells etc. by selling them to vendors collecting e- material.
- To help recycle the paper waste in the form of old newspapers/magazines etc. by selling them to the authorized vendors.

- To educate and make the faculty and students aware of the importance of proper waste management practices.
- To organize various awareness campaigns through the NSS Unit, various clubs and societies of the college for maintaining and cleaning the environment in and around the college campus.
