Introduction

The Skill Enhancement and Pre-Practice Programme at GHG Khalsa College of Education, Gurusar Sadhar, aimed to provide B.Ed Semester-3 students with essential skills and practical experience before their internship in August. This meticulously planned programme, held from July 24 to August 5, 2023, included various workshops, simulated teaching sessions, and innovative activities designed to enhance pedagogical skills. Under the dynamic leadership of Principal Dr. Pargat Singh Garcha and the dedicated efforts of internship in-charges Dr. Rachhpal Singh and Dr. Jasbir Kaur the programme ensured a comprehensive learning experience for future educators.

Orientation and Lesson Planning (July 24, 2023)

Orientation Session: Dr. Rachhpal Singh welcomed the participants and outlined the objectives of the programme. He emphasized the importance of teacher preparedness and the role of skill enhancement in effective teaching.





Introduction to Model-Based Lesson Planning: Dr. Pargat Singh introduced the concept of model-based lesson planning. He discussed various models of teaching, their concept, classification and important models of teaching, highlighting their application in classroom settings.



Micro Teaching Techniques (July 25, 2023)

Introduction to Micro Teaching: Dr. Jasleen Kaur introduced the concept of micro teaching, emphasizing its importance in refining teaching practices. She explained the process of micro teaching, which involves teaching a small segment of a lesson to a peer group, receiving feedback, and then re-teaching the segment with improvements. Skills of introducing a lesson, stimulus variation, blackboard writing and reinforcement were discussed in detail. Micro Lesson Preparation: Participants engaged in preparing micro lesson plans. Dr. Kaur provided guidance on selecting appropriate topics, defining clear objectives, and planning interactive activities. Participants practiced delivering their micro lessons and received constructive feedback from peers and mentors.



Workshop on Macro Lessons (July 26, 2023)

Macro Lessons Workshop: Dr. Manu Chadha led an engaging workshop on the preparation of macro lessons. She discussed the components of a macro lesson plan, including objectives, introduction, instructional procedures, guided practice, independent practice, and assessment. Participants worked in groups to create detailed macro lesson plans for their respective subjects



Social Media in Education (July 27, 2023)

ICT and Inclusiveness in Education

Participants learned to create ICT-based lesson plans and explore ways to incorporate technology into their classrooms.



Planning and execution of community related events (July 28, 2023)

Communication Skills Workshop (July 31, 2023)

Simulated Communication Scenarios: Participants engaged in simulated classroom scenarios, practicing various communication techniques. The interactive sessions helped enhance their ability to communicate effectively with students.

Field Visits and Outreach Activities (August 1, 2023)

They engaged in simulated teaching sessions, incorporating experiential learning from field visits and outreach activities into their pedagogy subjects.



Understanding Psychology of School Students (August 3, 2023)

Dr. Jasbir kaur delivered a powerpoint presentation on the topic 'Understanding Psychology of School students. She informed students that before carrying out the task of classroom teaching, it is essential that a teacher should make a good rapport in the class and establish a good bond with the students. Dr. Jasbir said it is essential to understand the psychology of each student for effective teaching as well as harmonious development of personality. She elaborated her topic with the issues and problems which need to be dealt with on a priority basis for successfully handling the stress of classroom students. She shared some screenshots with the students highlighting the aggressive tendencies among the adolescents leading to their involvement in unethical practices.



Library Resources and Learning Materials (August 4, 2023)

Importance of Library Resources: Mr. Hardeep Singh spoke about the significance of library resources and the use of stock registers. He highlighted the value of both online and offline learning materials in enhancing teaching and learning.
