


Day 2 (22.04.2023)


Day 4 (24.04.2024)

Day 5 (25.04.2024)


Mr. Jasvir Singh




Day 6 (26.04.2024)

On the 6th day of FSP (Finishing School Programme) participants watched a very fruitful session on the topic 'Tips for preparing for an interview and interview etiquettes.'Dr. Rekha Teji , Assistant Professor Malwa College of Education, Civil Lines , Ludhiana was resource person for this session. Dr.Rekha Teji started her discussion by defining the three phases of the interview and discussed in detail about their guidelines. Ma'am elaborated on the guidelines that are essential before going for the interview. Dr. Rekha concluded her session by enlisting some general questions asked during the interview, etiquette tips for face-to-face interview and do's and don'ts in an interview.
