400th Prakash Purab of the Ninth Sikh Guru, Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Ji *'Hind Di Chaadar: An Unparalleled Sacrifice'*

In the late 17th century, Mughal emperor Aurangzeb imposed the Sharia law across his empire and an additional jizya tax on non-Muslims. It is also believed that he forcibly converted many people to Islam some Kashmiri Pandits fled these forced conversions and sought refuge with Guru Tegh Bahadur, the ninth guru.

Guru Teg Bahadur resisted forced conversion of Hindus and Kashmiri Pandits and non-Muslims to Islam Mughal Emperor in Delhi. So, he travelled to Delhi to dissuade Aurangzeb from this religious imposition.

Aurangzeb asked him to bring forth someone willing to sacrifice himself for their religion and Guru Tegh volunteered himself. He had sacrificed his life to uphold the principles of religious freedom and amity and was, therefore, rightfully called as 'Hind di Chaadar',

Guru Tegh Bahadur was publicly beheaded on November 24th, 1675 on the orders of Mughal emperor Aurangzeb in Delhi. Great Guru occupies a special place in the country's history and was, rightfully titled as 'Hind di Chaadar'.

To commemorate the 400th birth anniversary of the ninth Sikh Guru, both the colleges have decided to organise a seminar to pay homage to the sacrificed life and to uphold the principles of religious freedom and amity.

This institution is associated with the name of Sri Guru Hargobind Sahib Ji, the sixth Guru, who once visited this place in 1657, symbol of Miri-Piri i.e. a combination of Spiritual as well as temporal authority. People of the area are grateful to late Nihang Shamsher Singh who selected this place as the nucleus of his spiritual and great educational adventure. In 1921, he started a modest Gurmukhi Pathshala (Vernacular primary school). In 1948, Intermediate College was started and later on, it became a Degree College. The Teacher Training (B.T.) was started in 1955 as a department of the Arts College with 100 seats. In 1957, the B.T. Department was transformed into an independent and full-fledged institute i.e. G.H.G. KHALSA COLLEGE OF EDUCATION. The College is awarded 'A' Grade (CGPA 3.30) by National Accreditation Assessment Council. The college is a Grant-in-aid college under 95% deficit grant-in-aid scheme of Govt. of Punjab and is recognized by University Grants Commission, New Delhi under 12 (B) & 2 (F) of the UGC Act. It is permanently recognized by National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi.


